

Brief Description of the Program

Career

The profession of a doctor is one of the oldest, most popular and respected at all times. A modern doctor should know a lot and be able to meet specific requirements. Medical community is a very competitive environment, so in order to take rightful place in it, you have to work hard and constantly improve your professional level. At the same time, medicine is one of the most interesting areas of human knowledge, where the opportunities for professional growth are virtually limitless.

Educational process

Already in the first year of their studies students are intensely immersed in the profession. They study a full range of modern medical disciplines of the therapeutic, surgical and obstetric profile, as well as general educational humanitarian and medical-biological subjects. The educational process is aimed at the formation of clinical thinking based on the principles of evidence-based medicine. During the first years of study, students mostly master theoretical medical and biological disciplines. Fourth- through sixth year students spend most of the study time in hospitals, studying clinical disciplines on the basis of a cycle system, where under the guidance of a doctor they perform a treatment and follow up of patients of an appropriate profile.

Practical training

Starting from the first year for study, a lot of attention is paid to practical training that students take in medical institutions of different clinical focus. While practicing, students master professional competence of junior medical personnel, including the use of training

devices and simulators. Further, during their work placement, medical students consolidate the acquired knowledge and skills in clinics, working as nurses, and later as assistant doctors. Senior students undergo specialized clinical practice, directly assisting patients in hospitals of different profiles.

Career

After successful completion the educational program, you will be able to enter clinical residency for in-depth specialization in the chosen field of medicine. In total, more than 100 narrow specializations are available for graduates. Possible work places: state and commercial medical institutions, public health authorities, social protection institutions of citizens, research institutes, medical offices in educational institutions and enterprises, institutions of secondary professional and higher education (medical faculties, universities, colleges). A graduate can work as a doctor, head of a department, a teacher, can become a scientist or open a private office (own business). For further career growth in institutions, you have to continue education in the field of medicine.
