

Brief Description of the Program

Profession

Professional activity of psychologists and social pedagogues covers such areas as education, culture, health care, and social sphere. The objects of their professional activities are training, education, socialization, individual and personal development of students, psychological, educational and social support for students, teachers and parents in educational organizations of various types.

Educational process

Undergraduate students study theoretical foundations of psychology and pedagogy, scientific achievements in the field of psychological and pedagogical support of an individual in the process of training, education and socialization.

The educational process is aimed at the formation of knowledge, motivation and practical experience in solving professional problems. Training is implemented with the use of modern educational technologies, electronic educational resources. All teachers involved in the program have a scientific degree and an academic title. Students have the opportunity to both take part in the scientific work of the department and to develop and implement their own research projects.

Practical training

There are four types of practical trainings in the program.

1. Practical training in obtaining primary professional skills. This practice is conducted in educational institutions of various types: pre-school institutions, schools, institutions for minors with deviant behavior, vocational education institutions. Students work with different categories of minors: orphans, gifted children, adolescents with deviant behavior, children and adolescents prone to suicide, children with disabilities.

2. Pedagogical practice is carried out in summer recreation camps. It is focused on the formation of experience of psychological and pedagogical work with children, organization of leisure activities.

3. Work experience in obtaining practical skills and professional experience is carried out in educational, health care and social institutions.

4. Pre-graduation practical training is aimed at consolidating, deepening and systematizing theoretical knowledge obtained at the university, selecting necessary information to perform final qualifying (bachelor's degree) work.

Career

Employment in educational organizations of different levels, in social service institutions for working with families, involvement in projects and programs for prevention of various kinds of addictions. The experience gained in the development and implementation of various social and research projects will allow you to quickly navigate in social relations and find for people a way out of difficult situations in family and at work.
