

## Brief Description of the Program

### Profession

Modern linguist-teachers are good at modern information and communication technologies, actively use them in education, exploit various methods and techniques of teaching a foreign languages to students with different educational needs and with different levels of language skills, take into account achievements of language sciences and its teaching in their professional activities .

### Educational Process

The educational program involves learning two foreign languages - English and French, various aspects of theoretical and applied linguistics, the development of methodology and research methods. Under the program, students receive comprehensive training in teaching foreign languages, linguistic and linguodidactic disciplines. Much attention is paid to the formation of the competencies of a linguist and teacher of foreign languages and cultures. Highly qualified, experienced teachers, trained at universities in the UK and the USA, are engaged in teaching students.

Seminars and master classes on problems of applied linguistics and teaching foreign languages, practical classes on in-depth study of foreign languages contribute to further acquiring specialized knowledge and skills necessary for successful teaching and research, development of educational programs, training materials, etc.

### Practical Training

They improve teaching and research skills of a linguist.

Upon completion of the educational program, graduates are given the opportunity to advance in the field of teaching foreign languages and cultures or to continue their studies under the graduate program. Knowledge of foreign languages allows masters of linguistics to get well-paid jobs in other areas, such as tourism and hotel business, international relations and trade, translation bureaus, state institutions, etc.

Linguists-teachers speak at least two foreign languages and carry out their professional activities in schools, universities, language centers. In addition, the Master of Linguistics can be employed as a translator or consultant on intercultural communication, as well as work in

the field of international journalism, carry out linguistic expertise, conduct scientific research of languages, and manage the design work of professional teams. Our graduates actively open language centers and find jobs in international language schools that offer online courses for children and adults around the world.
